Zai4
To be located

Made up of a shelter (on the left) and the earth radical (on the right)



Zhu4 To live

Made up of 'person' (on the left) and 'master' (on the right)



Na4 That

Get the right stroke order with this one and it will help you to distinguish it from other, similar looking characters




Na3 Which As in: Ni3 shi4 na3 guo2 ren2?

You are which nationality?



How to say 'where'

To the end of **以**, you add either:



or:

Get used to hearing or using both, even if you prefer to use one or the other



Examples

- 她在哪儿? Where is she
- 他在哪里? Where is he

• 他们在中国 He is in China

- 那是谁? Who is that?
- 她是谁? Who is she?

• 那儿 = there

Of course, you can also say:

那里

(Note that this character doesn't have the \square at the start and it is a 4th tone (na4) so that's why it sounds different from 'where')

Kate 在哪儿? Where is Kate?

• 在那儿 There.

• Silvio 在哪里? Where's Silvio?

• 在那里 There.

点 (dian3)

• A dian in Chinese is a dot or a little bit of something. It's a very useful concept which we'll keep coming back to.

The characters 海, 酒, 泪, 湖, 洋 are all related to water (sea, alcohol, tears, lake, ocean) and all have the short form of 水 on the left: 3 dots. This is called 三点水 (three dot water).

To say 'a little' you can say "one dot"

This makes a good response to the question: Can you speak Chinese?

This is often pronounced (especially in North East China) as 一点儿 or 一点儿点儿 (It sounds like: Eee diarrr diarr)
